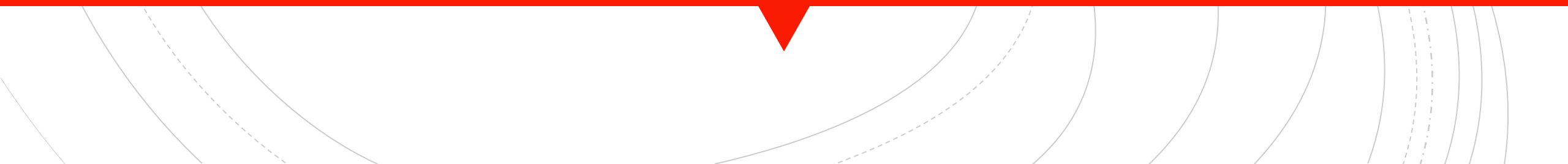

What is an ADT?

- **Associates Degree for Transfer**
- **A college associate's degree**
- **One set of requirements/major prep that will meet the major prep to transfer to multiple CSU's and some California private and out-of-state schools**

Completing an ADT will:

- **Guarantee admissions to the CSU system**
 - While you will be admitted to a CSU and guaranteed to transfer, you may not be admitted to the school of your choice.
- **Priority admissions consideration for some schools and some majors**
 - E.g. CSULA gives ADT applicants priority consideration.
 - These vary year to year, so check with a counselor
- **.1 Bump in your GPA**
 - E.g., 3.0 → 3.1
- **Guaranteed graduation within 60 units after transfer (potentially 2 years)**
 - Some schools will have you do more lower division preparation after transfer, but you will still graduate within 60 units.
 - E.g. Business Calc not required for CSULA or CSUDH but it is required for CSULB for business majors
- **Possible spring priority admission**

Benefits of
the ADT

To Receive an ADT you must:

- Complete either [CSUGE](#) or [IGETC](#)*
 - Complete the specified major requirements listed on the SMC major sheet
 - Receive a 2.0 GPA
 - Either:
 - Declare the ADT on your CSU application when you apply for transfer.
- OR
- If you do not declare the ADT on your application, you will have to submit an ADT graduation petition to SMC's Admissions and Records by the semester's deadline.

ADT Requirements

*CSU bound students must complete IGETC area 1C to be admissible to the CSU. UC bound students may earn an ADT completing the major requirements with IGETC, excluding 1C but including 6A (language other than English).

- Complete **all** ADT requirements by the end of:
 - The Spring before Fall transfer
 - The Summer before Spring transfer
